Its “green” features, as with its open architecture, can dramatically save time and, most importantly, money. Standard automatic duplexing and the unit’s strong scanning capabilities (fast speeds in all modes) help reduce paper consumption, while toner-save and auto-colour modes help extend the life of the cartridges. The ENERGY STAR-qualified and Germany Blue Angel-certified DCC 6626/DCC 6526 is equipped with ECOSYS technology, which provides long-life consumables to minimize environmental waste and TCO.

BLI highly recommends the 26-ppm colour/black DCC 6626/DCC 6526 for environments with monthly volumes of up to 6,000 impressions.
